He currently serves as project director for HNTB's general consulting engineering services for the New Jersey Turnpike Authority, and as senior technical adviser for Governor Cuomo's initiatives to reduce congestion in Manhattan while improving MTA transit services in New York City, currently known as Fix NYC. He also is project manager for the All-Electronic Tolling Infrastructure Design Services for the Goethals Bridge for the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey.

Le Frois has significant experience in toll project feasibility studies, tolling policies, toll road planning and design, managed lane planning and design, toll plaza and toll gantry layout and design, toll facility operations and toll collection systems. He has specialized expertise in advanced technologies in toll collection, including electronic toll collection utilizing automated vehicle identification systems, violation enforcement systems, and automated vehicle classification systems.

Le Frois is active in professional organizations, including the International Bridge, Tunnel and Turnpike Association. He also has penned numerous articles and technical papers, and has given many presentations regarding toll projects, policies, and general transportation infrastructure improvements.
